Matching Game

For families with kids 7 and younger:

1. Set up cards face-down on a table. Starting with the youngest player, take turns flipping over two cards at a time. The player keeps the cards; if they do not match, player turns the cards back over. Game is played until all of the cards are matched. The player with the most matches wins! As you play, take the time to share what the cards are about.

For families with kids 8-12:

1. Set up cards face-down on a table. Starting with the youngest player, take turns flipping over two cards at a time. If the player keeps the cards, they must explain a brief description of what that Basic Doctrine they just answered from the clue! If they find the correct Basic Doctrine match, they keep the cards. If they do not, they turn the cards back over. If they do not match, return the cards to the bowl. If player matches, game is played until all of the cards are matched. The player with the most matches wins!

For families with kids 12+:

1. Set up cards face-down on a table. This version of the game uses the clues found on this page. Cut the clues out, and put in a bowl! Starting with the youngest player, choose a clue from the bowl and hand to another player. The player listens to the clue and determines what Basic Doctrine it refers to. If they figure out the right answer to the clue, they can turn over two cards from the table—they are the Basic Doctrine they just answered from the clue! If they find the correct Basic Doctrine match, they keep the cards. If they do not, they turn the cards back over. If they do not match, return the cards to the bowl. If player matches, game is played until all of the cards are matched. The player with the most matches wins!

1. Being that all power and knowledge is from God. (Heavenly Father; this clue refers to the Godhead)

2. Came to earth, we lived in the _____ (Premortal World; this clue refers to the Plan of Salvation)

3. In Gethsemane, death on the cross, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. (Atonement)

4. Establishment of gospel truths through Joseph Smith is called the _____ (Restoration; this clue refers to the Dispensation of the Fulfillment of the Prophecy of Joseph Smith)

5. With Russel M. Nelson are examples of _____ (Prophets; this clue refers to Prophets and Revelation)

6. Power and authority from God. (Priesthood)

7. Promise is called a _____ (Covenant; this clue refers to Ordinances and Covenants)

8. Relationship between a man and a woman and is ordained of God. (Marriage; this clue refers to Marriage and Family)

9. Rules from God will, if kept, enable us to prosper. (Commandments)

10. It is our duty to learn the Basic Doctrines, write your own clues and play again and again!
