Matching Game

For Families with kids 7 and younger:

Set up cards face-down on a table. Starting with the youngest player, take turns flipping over two cards at a time. The player keeps the cards; if they do not match, player turns the cards back over. Game is played until all of the cards are matched. The player with the most matches wins! As you play, take the time to share what the cards are about.

For Families with kids 8-12:

Set up cards face-down on a table. Starting with the youngest player, take turns flipping over two cards at a time. If they match, player turns the cards back over. If they do not match, the player must explain a brief description of what that Basic Doctrine is. If the player can describe the Basic Doctrine, they get to keep the match. Game is played until all of the cards are matched. The player with the most matches wins!

For Families with kids 12+:

Set up cards face-down on a table. This version of the game uses the clues found on this page. Cut the clues out, and put in a bowl. Starting with the youngest player, choose a clue from the bowl and hand to another player. The player listens to the clue and determines what Basic Doctrine it refers to. If they figure out the right answer to the clue, they can turn over two cards from the table—they are Basic Doctrine they just answered from the clue! If they find the correct Basic Doctrine match, they keep the match. If not, they turn the cards over—even if the cards they answered are a match! Return clues to the bowl if player does not match. Game is played until all of the cards are matched. The player with the most matches wins!

A promise is called a _____. (Covenant; this clue refers to Ordinances and Covenants)

A relationship between a man and a woman and is ordained of God. (Marriage; this clue refers to Marriage and Family)

They are from God's will; if kept, enable us to prosper. (Commandments)
